

DAY BEFORE DUTY

- ✓ Check forecast & Tide
- ✓ Plan to arrive at the club atleast 1 hour and 15 mins before Start time.

ON ARRIVAL

- ✓ Meet with Race Officer 1 hour before the start time.
- ✓ Remember flags
- ✓ Confirm if all RIBs needed – RIB 4 maybe stood down if not needed, so could go sailing 😊

BEFORE START

- ✓ Move to windwards side of Lobster pontoon ASAP so dinghies can launch from leeward side.
- ✓ Encourage outgoing yachts to use the secondary channel during the start sequence.

DURING THE RACE

- ✓ Follow the last start out
- ✓ Cover course area advised by RO.
- ✓ Track Leader and Last of each Fleet.
- ✓ Report retirements to the Starter/recorder.
- ✓ Be ready to shorten if asked by RO.

- ✓ Confirm all boats signed off with Race Officer
- ✓ Tie up RIB as found and run cables ready for locking
- ✓ Return items to RIB Shed/fuel store
- ✓ Complete RIB Check list and log [Defects@warsashsc.org.uk](mailto:Defects@warsashsc.org.uk)
- ✓ Attend Bar to collect thanks from grateful sailors

WHEN BACK ASHORE

- ✓ Follow first boat home covering return to the river and slipway.
- ✓ Be prepared for RIB for crew to support the Starter/recorder recording finish times in the event of many boats or congested finish.

BEFORE RETURNING TO SHORE

Pass this mark on the required side and proceed to the start/finish line.	
Finish between this RIB and the adjacent mark of the course -	
Finish on a line between Pile 6&7
