# Supplementary Sailing Instructions to be read in conjunction with the 2025 RS Class Association Standard Sailing Instructions

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 RRS Appendix T (Arbitration) applies.
- 1.2 Competitors should note that Warsash Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the RYA Charter which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book.

#### 3. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the River Room Window at Shore House.
- 3.2 There will be competitor briefings at 10.30 on Saturday and 09.00 on Sunday in the Main Hall in Shore House.

#### 5. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the Shore House Flag Staff.
- When Flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced by 'not less than 60 minutes' in the race signal AP.

#### 7. CLASS FLAGS

7.1 The class flags will be:

RS200 RS200 Class Flag or if not available Numeral 2

RS400 RS400 Class Flag or if not available Numeral 4

RS600 RS600 Class Flag or if not available Numeral 6

#### 8. RACING AREA

- 8.1 The Race Area will be between Coronation and Darling Buoy which is approximately 1.5 miles from the Club. Any change to the intended Race Area will be announced at the briefing.
- 8.2 Competitors will be escorted to and from the Race Area.

#### 9. THE COURSE

- 9.1 Appendix A shows the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark will be passed.
- 9.2 No later than the warning signal, the number of laps and approximate bearing to the windward mark will be displayed from the Committee Boat. If only one number is shown, it applies to all classes.

#### 10. MARKS

- 10.1 Marks 1, 2,3S/P and 4S/P will be Orange inflatable buoys. Mark 1a will be a Black inflatable buoy.
- 10.2 The Outer Distance Starting Mark will be a Committee Boat or a Dan Buoy flying an Orange Flag.
- 10.3 The Outer Distance Finish Mark will be a small orange inflatable buoy.
- 10.4 The Race Committee may use marks of a different size/colour and the start and finish marks may both be in place at the same time.

#### 12. THE START

12.1 The intended start order is:

RS400

RS200

RS600

#### 13. THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the committee boat at the port end and the course side of the starboard-end finishing mark. This changes the RS Standard Sailing Instructions.

#### 14. OBSTRUCTIONS

14.1 There are not expected to be any obstructions on the race course.

#### 17 HEARING REQUESTS

17.1 Hearings will be held in the protest room off the upstairs bar area.

#### 19 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 19.1 [NP] Boats shall 'tally out' immediately before launching and 'tally in' immediately on returning ashore. Failure to comply with this SI will result in a 5-point penalty in the race closest to the infringement; other boats will not be rescored. A boat will not be scored worse than a disqualified boat because of this penalty. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.
- The Tally Board will be located adjacent to the Shore House Club House. Individual Tally Numbers will be issued at registration. The Tally board will close 15 minutes after the last boat returns ashore.
- 19.3 [NP] A boat that retires from a race shall notify the Race Committee as soon as possible and shall not leave the Race Area without the permission of the Race Committee.

#### 23 OFFICIAL VESSELS

23.1 Official Vessels will display a Warsash Sailing Club logo or flag.


#### **Appendix A - Courses**

A.1 All marks are to be rounded to port and repeated for the displayed number of laps.

A.2 The course and number of laps to be sailed will be displayed on the side of the Committee Boat.
